**PREPARATION AND PRESENTATION OF FINANCIAL**  
**STATEMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ACCRUAL BASED IPSAS**

**(03<sup>rd</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> June 2019 - IAA Arusha Campus, Arusha)**

**1.0 COURSE BACKGROUND**

IPSASs exist to improve the quality of general purpose financial reporting by public sector entities, leading to better informed assessments of resource allocation decisions made by governments and other agencies, thereby increasing transparency and accountability. In this 4 weeks course IPSAS requirements will be explained in clear, simple language and illustrated with model financial statements and real-world examples. Application of the various standards is illustrated through the use of short case studies. In addition to a review of current accrual basis IPSAS, our specialist instructors will also give guidance on transitioning to the accrual IPSAS and on the specifics of IPSAS implementation under IPSAS 33 *First-time Adoption*.

**2.0 COURSE CONTENTS**

This program answers questions such as:

- What are the current requirements for presentation of accrual basis IPSAS financial statements and related disclosures?
- Where can technical and practical guidance on IPSAS be found?
- How have IPSASs changed recently, and what changes can be expected going forward?
- What practical issues commonly arise when implementing IPSASs?
- What are the requirements for transitioning from cash or modified cash basis to the accrual basis of accounting?

**3.0 TARGET GROUP**

The course is intended for assistant accountants, accountants and auditors.

**4.0 METHODOLOGY**

The training will utilize a variety of adult learning techniques to ensure maximum understanding, comprehension as well as the retention of the information disseminated.

**5.0 FEES & MODE OF PAYMENT:**

The fee for the course is **TZS 3,500,000/=** (say **Three Million Five Hundred Thousand only**) per participant to cover tuition fee, training material, tea and lunch.
