1.0 COURSE BACKGROUND

Most developing countries are faced with huge budgetary constraints which need to be addressed through greater participation of private sector. Due to lack of realistic and comprehensive technical, social-economic and commercial feasibility analysis which leads to poor project design, an organization needs to be equipped with knowledge on Public Private Partnerships enabling understanding of environment and appropriate risk sharing mechanisms public private partnership. Therefore, to be provided with the knowledge a five days short course will help you walk away with the skills and up-to-date knowledge you need in executing PPP projects. You will be able to initiate PPP projects; use appropriate methods of Procurement Contract process based on PPPs and identify feasible and viable PPP projects.

- The various forms of procurement including competitive bidding, competitive negotiations, and sole sourcing
- Methods for structuring bid evaluation criteria

DAY THREE : PROCUREMENT PLANNING UNDER PPP

- Using the PPP contract as a regulatory instrument
- Establishing an independent regulatory framework for PPP
- The forms of economic regulation, including price cap & rate-of-return
- Monitoring contractors' performance through Key Performance Indicators (KPI)

DAY FOUR : Procurement under PPP

- Methods for managing stakeholder relations
- Structuring a communications program
- Addressing the human resources and labor relations implications of PPP

DAY FIVE : PPP Tanzania experience
